A. BASIC TERMS

3.	Name of Competition/ Programme	ARE YOU LITE ENOUGH?
4.	Brief Description of Competition	"ARE YOU LITE ENOUGH?" is a Competition organized by the Organiser to giveaway cash prize or vouchers.
5.	Brief mechanism of Competition	ROUND 1: WHAT'S THAT 80'S SONG? *EACH ROUND, THE POINT SYSTEM WILL RESET TO ZERO (0) 1. Eight (8) Contestants which has been selected by the Organiser will compete against each other. 2. Each Contestant will be given a buzzer. 3. An audio snippet (containing songs from the 80s/80s banger) with a duration of three (3) seconds will be played. 4. The fastest Contestant that hits the buzzer will be given the chance to answer within five (5) seconds to obtain a point. 5. If the Contestant is unable to give the correct answer within the stipulated time, the host can open to the floor for another Contestant to submit an answer. There will be only one (1) chance for the same audio snippet to be answered by the other Contestants. 6. Top six (6) Contestants with THREE (3) points will move to Round 2. ROUND 2: WHO'S THAT CELEBRITY? *EACH ROUND, THE POINT SYSTEM WILL RESET TO ZERO (0) 1. Each Contestant will be given a buzzer. 2. An audio snippet (containing snippets of Hollywood celebrities in movies) with a duration of three (3) seconds will be played. 3. The fastest Contestant that hits the buzzer will be given the chance to answer within five (5) seconds to obtain a point. 4. If the Contestant is unable to give the correct answer within the stipulated time, the host can open to the floor for another Contestant to submit an answer. There will be only one (1) chance for the same audio snippet to be answered by the other Contestants. 5. Top four (4) Contestants with THREE (3) points will move to Round 3. ROUND 3: GUESS THAT SONG IN REVERSE 1. The four (4) Contestants will be split into TWO (2) Semi Final Rounds and TWO (2) Final Rounds. See the illustration below:
		SEMI FINAL 1: Contestant A will compete against Contestant B. SEMI FINAL 2: Contestant C will compete against Contestant D.

	If Contestant A and C wins, Contestant A and C will compete in the Final Round for the 1 st and 2 nd Place. While Contestant B and D will compete in the Final Round for the 3 rd and 4 th Place.
	 Each Contestant will be given a buzzer. An audio snippet (containing snippet of a song in reverse) with a duration of three (3) seconds will be played. The fastest Contestant that hits the buzzer will be given the chance to answer within five (5) seconds to obtain a point.
	SHOULD THE PARTICIPANT SEEK HELP FROM OTHER PARTICIPANTS, (BOTH) OF THEIR POINTS WILL RESET TO ZERO (0)
	The Contestants must adhere to the mechanism of the Competition as may be briefed and communicated to the Contestants by the Organiser during the Competition Period.
6. Eligibility Criteria	a) The Competition is open to all Malaysians of the Age of Eligibility below.
	b) Contestants must be Malaysian citizens and must possess valid Malaysian Identity Cards.
7. Ineligibility	The following persons are not eligible to participate in the Competition :-

	(b) Has won any prize(s) up to a value either individually or collectively of a value of RM1,000 and below from the Radio Station in the period of thirty (30) days prior to entering the Competition.
	(c) Has won any prize(s) up to a value either individually or collectively of a value of RM1,001 to RM5,000 from the Radio Station in the period of ninety (90) days prior to entering the Competition.

		The Organiser's default method to pay the cash prize shall be by telegraphic transfer to the winner's bank account. The winner must provide accurate bank account or transfer details to the Organiser.
